**In 2010 / 2011 we invite all schools attending all concerts featuring Saskatoon Symphony Musicians to submit their own creative art designs relating to 'Holst: The Planets', which is the season finale of the SSO on May 21, 2011. The submission must be somehow connected to the music.**

**Suggestions for these artistic endeavours will be featured in the SSO Education Package given to your school upon booking a school concert - Be one of the first to participate in this new Saskatoon Symphony initiative!**

Contest entries Close: March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2011. We are interested in an art project that represents the music of Gustav Holst, The Planets. Simply work through the activities available in the education resource package available to your school relevant to the concert you and your students will be attending. Each activity culminates in a composition activity aimed at depicting that particular selection of music.

Students may submit individual or group compositions – even a composition by a whole class or school. It is our intention to include the art work in a display at Saskatoon's Mendel Art Museum and feature many works as part of the SSO Master Series concert of the Planets.
