## Community Music Education Programs

### **Music in Early Childhood for children ages 3 to 6**

The Music in Early Childhood program is a 30-week program that starts in September of each year. Three-year-olds and their parents attend once weekly for 45 minutes. Four, five and six-year-olds attend once weekly for one hour.

Fall Term starts September 6, 2008. Classes resume January, 2009

Fee: 3-year olds - \$300 (30 x 3/4 hour lessons) • 4-6-year olds - \$330 (30 x 1 hour lessons)

### **Instrument and Voice Lessons for children ages 6 and up**

Enroll your child in individual music or voice lessons. Our classes are taught by qualified instructors (ARCT piano certification or a Bachelor's degree in Music). There are 34 lessons, available on Mondays, Wednesdays and Thursdays starting in September.

- **Traditional Piano Instruction:** Traditional method requires a commitment of practicing daily. An acoustic or digital piano at home is necessary.
  - **Traditional Voice Instruction**
  - **Traditional Violin Instruction:** a violin for practice at home is necessary.
  - **Traditional Guitar Instruction:** an acoustic guitar for practice at home is necessary.

### **Around the World Music Camps for children ages 3 to 6**

Around the World Music Camps are designed to introduce your child to the exciting world of music. Children will explore various cultures, using songs, games and instruments. These half-day camps are held the first three weeks in August.

- Aug. 4-8: Music Camp for Ages 3-4, 9:30-11:30 am or 1:30-3:30 pm
  - Aug. 11-15: Music Camp for Ages 4-5, 9:00-12:00 or 1:00-4:00 pm
  - Aug. 18-22: Music Camp for Ages 5-6, 9:00-12:00 or 1:00-4:00 pm
- Fee: Age 3-4 camp is \$100 and the other two sessions (4-5 and 5-6) are \$125.

**Parenting with Music** is a 10-week program with start dates in September and January. Classes are held once per week for 40 minutes. Singing rhymes with your baby will provide a wonderful bond-forming communication while establishing a foundation for future development in language, mathematics, music and movement. **Parenting with Music** will teach you and your child traditional nursery repertoire, finger and toe plays, bouncing rhymes, lullabies and songs.
